Youth Choir

Farnham Youth Choir is an award-winning family of choirs with an international reputation. But more than that, we are a collection of people who believe in the joy of singing, the power of music and the incredible transferable skills that music making offers. We are a registered charity.

Farnham Youth Choir runs three choirs:

Training Choir – for children between 6 and 9, our Training Choir is a fun singing group that introduces our youngest singers to the teamwork and excitement of singing and performing together. Training Choir members can move onto our Junior Choir when they reach the top of the age range.

Junior Choir – our Junior Choir is where children start to experience some of the amazing performance opportunities that come our way. The choir takes part in festivals and competitions and is asked to perform with other groups. In 2023, the Junior Choir will be singing with the National Symphony Orchestra and London Symphony Chorus for a world-premiere performance at Cadogan Hall in London.

Senior Choir – From about age 13 onwards, our singers can join the Senior Choir. This is our main competitive choir – our singers have performed on radio and television, at the Royal Albert Hall and internationally at singing festivals. The choir sings at an extremely high standard and has made many professional recordings.

In total, more than 100 children come to Farnham every week to sing, learn and make lifelong friendships. We run a bursary scheme so we can welcome every child who wants to sing, and we have ambitious plans for the future.

Farnham Youth Choir has a rolling membership of around 100 families. We also run an alumni scheme, where past singers and families are kept up to date with news, concerts and events. This audience is very open to engaging with organisations that support their children's activities.

In addition, we have a loyal and supportive local following. Our Christmas Concerts sell out early and because we travel around Surrey, London and the wider UK, our choirs have great visibility among audiences with a mainly AB profile.

Special Events

During the course of the season, we host a number of special events. This year, our biggest event is our 40th anniversary concert, which will be held in London. This will be a prestigious event, and we plan to commission a new piece of music to have its world premiere at this event.

We're also organising a Singing Spree – a dedicated event for Farnham schoolchildren, which will be held at The Maltings. This is a great opportunity to get children engaged by the power of singing and is a fantastic community event.

40th anniversary commission sponsorship, 2024: £5000+

A unique opportunity to sponsor the commission of a new piece of music to celebrate FYC's 40th anniversary. The sponsor's name will be on the printed music and acknowledged in the programme; four tickets for the concert (March 2024) where the piece will have its world premiere. Where appropriate, the sponsor will also have a full page ad in the 40th anniversary concert programme.

FYC Singing Spree, Farnham June 2023, : £1000

The FYC Singing Spree is a joyous occasion that brings together over a 150 of Farnham's Year 2 schoolchildren to experience a singing workshop led by some of the UK's leading choral conductors. Last year, a teacher said, 'A thoroughly engaging and enjoyable hour of singing! The children have gone back to their classrooms singing the songs with big smiles on their faces. Thank you!' The sponsor's name will be on materials sent home with the children after the event; logo and thanks in the weekly briefing sent to all our parents (approximately 150 local families) and in our termly supporters' newsletter. All supporters are thanked liberally on social media and on our website.

Bursary Scheme

Until 2021, Farnham Youth Choir aimed informally to assist singers' families who struggled to pay membership subscriptions. The pandemic, and the hardships it has brought, taught us that we needed to formalise this process and thus the **FYC Bursary Scheme** was born.

The Fund removes the affordability barrier, both for children who would like to join an award-winning choir like FYC, and for children who already sing with us but whose families face financial difficulty at any time.

So far, we have funded this scheme through fundraising and grant awards, and we are always interested in talking to organisations who might like to support this scheme as an alternative to sponsorship support.

Annual sponsorship of a Senior Choir singer: £750

Annual sponsorship of a Junior or Training Choir singer: ± 300

Annual sponsorship of a singer to go on tour: £1000

These sponsorships will be acknowledged on our website and in concert programmes.
